



To Get Started, Download No Idling Resource Sample Packet



Step 1: Administration: Please review and modify sample letters and policies. Staff: Install No Idling signs at sites.

Principals or Staff: Announce the No Idling Resolution for Children's Health, Safety, Clean Air, Water, Nontoxic Land and the Environment. Review No Idling Resource Sample Packet. Pass out Pledge Forms, The No Idling Resolution, Contest and Challenge Flyers and the School and District Challenge Tracking Sheets.

Review the No Idling Powerpoint or other source of information (5 minutes).

Step 2: Office Staff: Start the No Idling Pledge and Information drive. Materials: half-sheet pledge and half-sheet letter to parents, drivers and delivery workers. (Optional: provide certificates and No Idling Logos to students who collect pledge forms and drivers who sign the pledge.)

Step 3: Teachers may review No Idling Curriculum and Information on CleanEarth4Kids.org or other sites.

Determine which contests are a fit for students. Or, send the flyer home to provide the opportunity to contests and challenges at home. (Optional: modify and create your own rubrics, materials, etc.)

Step 4: Provide Flyer of Contests for No Idling and Pollution Solutions for Air, Water and Land: Sign, Poster, Comic, Adventure Story, Song, Rap, Poem, Essay, Presentation.

Step 5: Review the Challenges for students, teachers, principals and staff challenges for school (or districts, city or state.)

Step 6: Display student work from contests in schools, district, city buildings, local businesses. Count # displayed. Photograph for School Challenge.
